TIME COMMITMENT

- September 2016-June 2017
- 3-4 hours per week
 - Preparation for weekly role
 - Arranging for another student to fill your role if you cannot make it
 - Thursday or Friday Youth night
 - Letting Pastor Andrew know when special circumstances arise and you cannot make it
- Monthly Student Leader meeting
- Occasional special events

MISSIONAL COMMITMENT

- Keep growing in your relationship with Christ through personal time spent praying and studying the Bible (Equip)
- Foster an environment of inclusivity at HSSM by showing genuine kindness and interest toward all students and leaders (Connect)
- Encourage other students to grow in their faith by mentoring younger HSSM students and sharing the gospel with friends outside of HSSM (Mobilize)

CHARACTER COMMITMENT

- Aim to grow in the characteristics of 1 Timothy 3
- Recognize that you are an ambassador for Christ first and HSSM after that - other people are watching your example
- Remember you are a child of grace (Ephesians 2:8) and a work in progress (Philippians 1:6)
- Be willing to listen to advice and instruction from Pastor Andrew and other adult leaders

SERVICE COMMITMENT

- Be responsible for 1 role/task that you are passionate about and skilled for (decided upon by you and Pastor Andrew)
- Complete the role you choose with enthusiasm and effort weekly
 - Plan for your role with other leaders
 - Arrive before the Youth night to prepare for your role

- Invest in you by:
 - Partnering you with adult leaders who care about your growth
 - Giving you weekly opportunities to develop in an area of service you enjoy
 - Taking time monthly to train you as a maturing leader
 - Taking you to certain special events and conferences throughout the year
