Option #1: Finding I Am with Lysa TerKeurst

What is the deep cry of your heart? The prayer you keep repeating? Jesus not only cares about this deep, spiritual wrestling, but He also wants to step in and see you through it. Join Lysa TerKeurst on the streets of Israel to explore the seven I AM statements of Jesus found in the Gospel of John. Through this interactive, in-depth study, you will learn to:

- Trade feelings of emptiness and depletion for a more personal fulfillment from knowing who Jesus is.
- Stop living like a slave to your circumstances by training your heart to embrace the life-giving freedom God wants for you.
- Gain a better understanding of how Jesus' words 2,000 years ago are so very applicable to the answers we are searching for today.

The study guide includes five weeks of personal study segments to complete between six weeks of group sessions. Each week leads you through four days of study with an optional fifth day.

Option #2: Missional Motherhood with Gloria Furman

Sooner or later, every mother will stop and ask herself, *Is this all I am?* God has instilled motherhood with meaning and purpose as part of His greater plan for humanity. Whether or not a woman has been called to traditional motherhood, she demonstrates her nurturing gifts daily through caregiving, hospitality, discipleship, teaching, raising children, and serving others. This study is not one that focuses on finding new ways of dealing with the pressing needs of our daily lives, but rather encourages us to look at the big picture of God's grand plan. Motherhood is not just a helpful social construct, but authored by God for specific

purposes. Jesus invites all women to follow His pattern, to trust His promises, and to nurture others by the power He provides.

Join Gloria Furman in this 6-session Bible study as she looks to Scripture for evidence of God's mission for motherhood and His greater purpose for each and every woman. Our weekly teaching sessions will be an opportunity to view a short video (approx. 15 min) and engage in interactive discussions together. The study guide includes five weeks of personal study segments divided over four days. The homework isn't time consuming so everyone is encouraged to get a book so we can join together to review the material in our discussion times each week.

Option #3: First Principles of the Faith: Becoming a Disciple

This is the first book of the Series that the Grandview church body is being encouraged to study.

The concept of becoming a disciple is central to the entire message and mission of Jesus Christ. This book is designed to take you through a simple process of examining the Bible for yourself, carefully thinking through what it means to become a disciple of Jesus and integrating what you have learned into your life. This series is designed to lead you through a discussion-based learning process. Each week's lesson has required homework of 30-45 minutes which will prepare you to discuss the issues when we meet together. The class is a discussion-based Bible study so participation by everyone in the group is a critical component of this course.

This class is limited to the first 14 women who register.

The books will be available at the Welcome Centre as the first week of homework needs to be completed before you begin on April 10.
