Study Descriptions:

Option #1: God of Covenant (Jen Wilkin)

God of Covenant is a 10-session Bible Study on Genesis 12-50 which studies the stories of the fathers of our faith - Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph. The study walks you through verse by verse, tracing the themes of covenant, resurrection, redemption, and hope. The study guide includes 5 days of personal study each week along with small group discussion questions and a weekly viewer guide.

Through this study, discover how God orchestrates everything for His glory and the good of His people, and see how the God of creation and covenant is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Option #2: Forever. Why You Can't Live Without It (Paul Tripp)

A 10-week video series of a live conference with Paul David Tripp.

You may be suffering from Eternity Amnesia. The Bible assures us that God has placed eternity in our hearts, that we were hard-wired for forever. But in a world that is broken and suffering, it's easy to forget this, loading up the here and now with expectations that will only be fulfilled in eternity. This always ends in frustration and disappointment.

Paul Tripp points out that having an eternity perspective will enable us to live for something bigger than ourselves and larger than this moment and be able to lead lives of greater significance and peace.

While there is no study guide or written homework, participants are encouraged to purchase the book "Forever" and read the recommended chapters that support the video content from week to week.
